#### Access to the campsite by road

**- From Rouen:** A28 - exit 1 Baie de Somme- Le Crotoy. Then head towards Le Crotoy via the D40 and D940. At the entrance of Le Crotoy, at the first roundabout, go straight on, at the 2nd roundabout turn right, then 1st left, drive 500m and the campsite is on the right. You have arrived!

**- From Paris, Reims, Amiens, Calais, Brussels and Amsterdam:** Motorway A16 - exit 23 Abbeville Nord. Head towards Le Crotoy by the D40 and D940. At the entrance of Le Crotoy, first roundabout, go straight on, at the 2nd roundabout turn right, then 1st left, drive 500m and the campsite is on the right. You have arrived!

#### Before leaving, remember to check :

- your vehicle (tires, levels, lights ...)
- your emergency kit
- if you have tent, caravan, motorhome ... do not forget your material (sardines, tires, European electrical connection, extension ...)

- Pitches are available from 14.00 on day of arrival
- Mobile homes are available from 16.00 on the day of arrival
- Premium lodges are available from 15.00 on the day of arrival

If you arrive late, please call us before 17.00 on 0033.(0)3.22.27.01.34 to agree on an arrangement to collect keys.

### On arrival a security deposit will be required :

- For mobile homes standards and comforts : 200€ (cottage) and 95€ (end of stay cleaning)
- For 2 bedroom and 2 bathroom comfort mobile homes or premium lodges :
  200€ (cottage) and 115€ (end of stay cleaning)
- For the 4 bedrooms lodge : 200€ (cottage) and 140€ (end of stay cleaning)

Deposit of securities by credit card imprint.

#### If you arrive early, we recommend you :

- eat at Pause en Baie in the campsite
- take a ride on the port of Le Crotoy, the Jules Noiret dam for a taste of the resort
- or a ride along the Bassée (1 km from the campsite) for birdwatching and admire the Henson horses
